

# **SCRIPTURE MEMORY B ~ Teen Lightning 2019** (March 28-29)

12. (*Psalms* 63:1-3) “**1 O God, thou art my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is; 2 To see thy power and thy glory, so as I have seen thee in the sanctuary. 3 Because thy lovingkindness is better than life, my lips shall praise thee.**”

*Note: The above 3-verse passage may be quoted to gain **3** points for your team*

13. (*Psalms* 19:7-11) “**7 The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul: the testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple. 8 The statutes of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart: the commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes. 9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring for ever: the judgments of the LORD are true and righteous altogether. 10 More to be desired are they than gold, yea, than much fine gold: sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb. 11 Moreover by them is thy servant warned: and in keeping of them there is great reward.**”

14. (*Psalms* 121:1-8) “**1 I will lift up mine eyes unto the hills, from whence cometh my help. 2 My help cometh from the LORD, which made heaven and earth. 3 He will not suffer thy foot to be moved: he that keepeth thee will not slumber. 4 Behold, he that keepeth Israel shall neither slumber nor sleep. 5 The LORD is thy keeper: the LORD is thy shade upon thy right hand. 6 The sun shall not smite thee by day, nor the moon by night. 7 The LORD shall preserve thee from all evil: he shall preserve thy soul. 8 The LORD shall preserve thy going out and thy coming in from this time forth, and even for evermore.**”

15. (*1 Peter* 4:12-16) “**12 Beloved, think it not strange concerning the fiery trial which is to try you, as though some strange thing happened unto you: 13 But rejoice, inasmuch as ye are partakers of Christ's sufferings; that, when his glory shall be revealed, ye may be glad also with exceeding joy. 14 If ye be reproached for the name of Christ, happy are ye; for the spirit of glory and of God resteth upon you: on their part he is evil spoken of, but on your part he is glorified. 15 But let none of you suffer as a murderer, or as a thief, or as an evildoer, or as a busybody in other men's matters. 16 Yet if any man suffer as a Christian, let him not be ashamed; but let him glorify God on this behalf.**”

*Note: Any of the above 5-verse or 8-verse passages may be quoted to gain **4** points for your team*

## Please know:

- (1) There are a total of **20** Bible passages for you to memorize and quote. As we have issued the above **15** passages to you (7 days early) ... when you arrive to the Youth Conference (on Thursday morning), you will be given the remaining **5** Bible passages to memorize.

Those remaining **5** Bible passages are:

- \* 2 more of a 1-verse passage
- \* 2 more of a 2-verse passage
- \* 1 more of a 5-verse passage

- (2) All 15 of your 1-verse and 2-verse passages must be quoted before you can begin to quote any of the 3-verse or 5-verse or 8-verse passages.

- (3) Why do we put such an emphasis on memorizing Bible passages?

Because Bible reading & Bible preaching & Bible memorization are the three influences that will best-direct your life in a God-pleasing way.
